


#### **Materials**

- A4 Paper or card (110 200 GSM)
- Colouring things (pencils/pens etc) Sticky tape
- Ruler
- · Scissors / craft knife
- Table knife / bone folder
- Thin ribbon, string or embroidery thread 12cm +
- Glue or double sided sticky tape

#### Making

- 1. Print templates. The heavier the paper, the easier it is to assemble
- 2. Colour to your heart's desire
- 3. Cut out your template along the white edge.
- 4. Scoring & Folding (scoring makes folding accurately much easier) Scoring: with a ruler as a guide, run the back of a table knife or bone folder...
- a. **Front** along the tab lines (see 4a)

### Making continued

4. Scoring & Folding (scoring makes folding accurately much easier)
Scoring: with a ruler as a guide, run the back of a table knife or bone folder...
b. **Back** (see 4b)

Folding: Crease all scored lines, plain sides together

Point A




6. Ribbon & tape

5. At the tip of the triangles use sticky tape to fix your ribbon to the back.

6. Assemble shape
Use glue or double sided sticky tape to connect tabs 1,2 &3 under neath side
A,B & C. Use your finger tips to help press the surfaces together.
Then stick tabs 4&5 to the remaining sides


Then stick tabs 4&5 to the remaining sides D& E.




# Wingea Beasts Pegasus


# Winged Beasts Cockatrice


